GENERAL SURGEON WITH SPECIALIZATION IN VASCULAR SURGERY

"I think medicine is still an art despite the significant advance made in technology to facilitate the delivery of care. All I care about – all I want a patient to know about me is – at the end of the day, after seeing me, the patient feels slightly better."

EXTENDING A LIFELINE

TEAMWORK CREATES VASCULAR ACCESS CLINIC

Dr. Cadet led the creation of The Vascular Access Clinic at Beloit Hospital. The Clinic provides preventative and emergency care for patients with chronic kidney disease who undergo hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis on a regular basis. The Vascular Access Clinic supports the maintenance and care of access ports required for dialysis treatments.

SAVING TIME. SAVING LIVES.

For patients suffering end stage renal disease, dialysis is a lifeline. Without a functional dialysis port,

a patient cannot receive the treatments they need to survive. In the past, patients would have to travel out of town to receive care for a failed or compromised port. The Vascular Access Clinic at Beloit Hospital provides care right here in Beloit. "A vascular access program at the System means improved Quality care for patients – better care and more convenient and while we're following standard practice guidelines," says Dr. Cadet.

JENNIFER KAFKA, RN

COORDINATOR, VASCULAR ACCESS CLINIC

Jennifer has been a dialysis nurse for more than 8 years. Many of her patients receive dialysis 3 times a week for 3-4 hours each visit. Working together with Dr. Cadet and other team members, Jennifer sees an improvement in the care for her patients. “Having a Vascular Access Clinic here at Beloit Hospital means patients can stay in the community for on-going care of their access,” she says adding, “In the past, patients had to travel to Madison or Milwaukee to just receive care for their access.”

“I am proud of the patient satisfaction. Patients are satisfied that they have a vascular access surgeon here at the Center. It gives them peace of mind that if they have any emergency needs they can come here for their care. Dr. Cadet is very good about getting patients in right away and resolving their issues.”



LIVING OUR VALUES

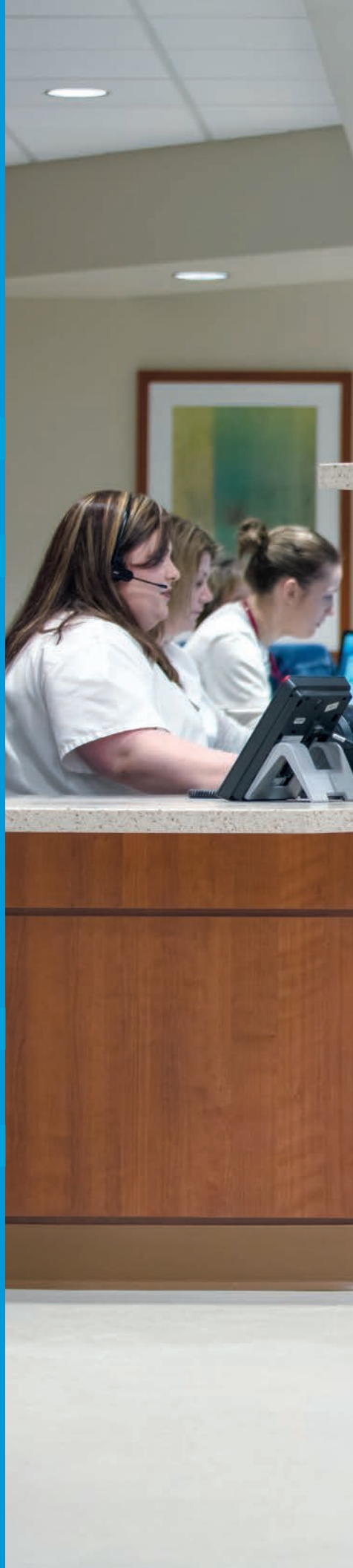

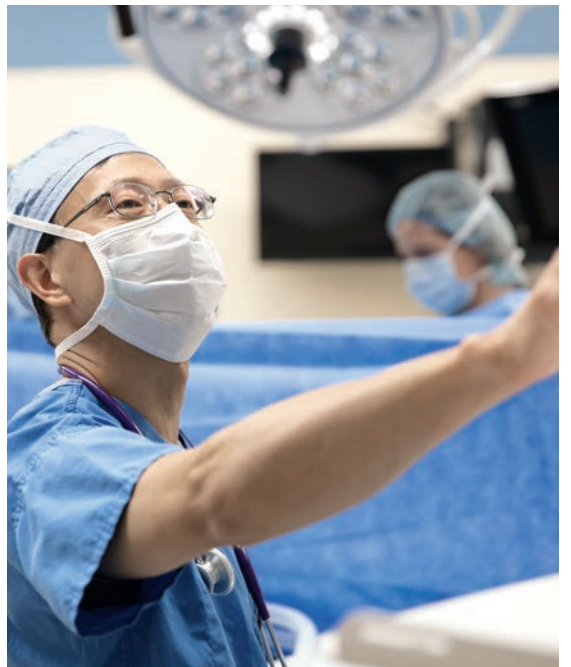




NORTHPOINTE SURGERY CENTER

HENDRICKS FAMILY HEART HOSPITAL

Encompassing the entire fourth floor of Beloit Hospital, the \$14 million Hendricks Family Heart Hospital is the region's destination for heart care. The Heart Hospital pairs a highly trained, dedicated staff with technology that rivals any large metropolitan health center. Patients needing heart-related care can get everything in one location, from diagnostics and testing, to treatments and follow-up.

Setting the Heart Hospital apart from other hospitals in the region is a modern operating suite that enables interventional cardiologists and cardiothoracic surgeons to transition from a cardiac catheterization procedure to open heart surgery without ever leaving the room. The Hybrid Operating Suite features technology at the forefront of medical science and enables physicians to perform new heart and vascular procedures previously only available in larger cities.

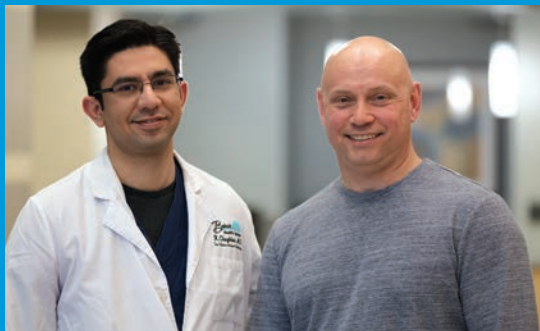

March 9, 2016 is a day that Steve Peck will remember for the rest of his life. He was going about an average workday at Frito-Lay when he collapsed on his job. His co-workers came to his aid by giving him CPR

and calling 911. On the way to the hospital, his pulse was lost several times and upon arriving at Beloit Hospital, he was in critical condition. The Emergency Room staff stabilized Steve and called the Heart and Vascular team. Dr. Haroon Chughtai and the team saved Steve's life. At the time, Steve was oblivious as to what was happening around him but says that Dr. Chughtai saved him and that he is forever grateful for the compassion and quality care that he received at Beloit Health System. Steve recently celebrated the one-year anniversary of his heart attack and is taking every day as a new day and enjoying his life and family.

LEAPFROG HOSPITAL SAFETY GRADE A



Beloit Hospital received the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade of "A" for patient safety. The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade uses national performance measures from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the Leapfrog Hospital Survey, the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the American Hospital Association's Annual Survey and Health Information Technology Supplement to reach a composite score that represents a hospital's overall performance in keeping patients safe from preventable harm and medical errors.



ADVANCED JOINT CARE CENTER

A JOINT COMMISSION AND QUALITY PATH CERTIFIED PROGRAM

The Advanced Joint Care Center at Beloit Memorial Hospital is part of an elite group of just 31 programs nationwide, and the only program in Wisconsin, to earn The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval® for Advanced Certification for Total Hip and Total Knee Replacement.

This patient-centered program provides coordinated care from a multi-disciplinary team of surgeons, advanced practice providers, nurses, and physical and occupational therapists. A Joint Care Coordinator guides each patient through the program, serving as their champion even after they leave the hospital.

As a Quality Path certified program, The Advanced Joint Care Center is a preferred care provider for many large employers who participate in the Alliance, an employee coalition representing 240 employers represented locally by the City of Beloit, School District of Beloit, Woodman's Market, North American Tool, and First National Bank.

Joint replacement at the Advanced Joint Care Center is a unique, Quality experience that uses the expertise of an entire team of healthcare professionals to return patients to an active lifestyle as quickly as possible.

ADVANCED PRIMARY STROKE CENTER A JOINT COMMISSION CERTIFIED PROGRAM

In October 2016, two years after earning a designation as a Primary Stroke Center, Beloit Health System's stroke program earned The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval® for Advanced Primary Stroke Centers. During a rigorous on-site inspection, the Joint Commission evaluated compliance with stroke-related standards and requirements, including program management, the delivery of clinical care, and performance improvement. The designation sets the program apart as a leader in stroke care, providing a higher standard of service for stroke patients our community.

Beloit Health System first earned Primary Stroke Center designation in 2014. As with any Quality

initiative, the Stroke Center requires a team effort. There are many pieces to the team, including the stroke coordinator, medical director, emergency room physicians, and nurses. On the unit, a specially trained stroke nurse along with the team in radiology, speech, lab, physical and occupational therapy all have important roles in the care of stroke patients. High quality stroke care is time dependent. As a result, the team strives for standardization of care – every patient, every time.

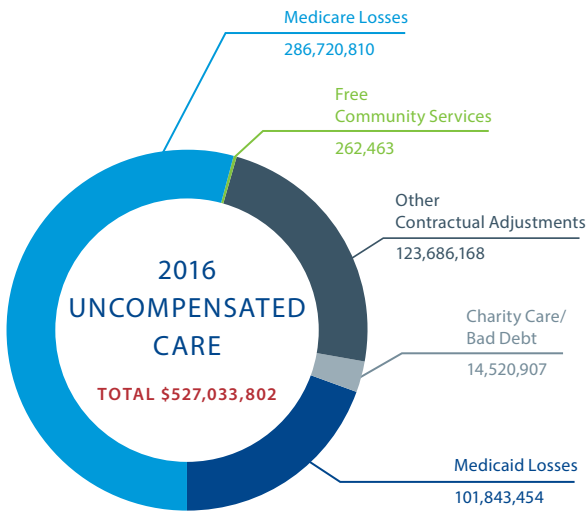
