Success at Beloit Health System comes in many forms, from defining and accelerating a career to caring for patients.

Arlene Smock is a great example of how BHS elevates employees to a successful and rewarding career.

"I worked at BHS as a CNA while I went to school. I did two years of nursing on the med-surg floor and earned a position in labor and delivery. I then worked as a nurse in the OB department, and along the way I decided to go into leadership."

Arlene is now the clinical manager of the Packard Family Care Center, and soon to be the clinical manager at the Freestanding Birth Center. Her accomplishments are a direct result of career opportunities at BHS, her determination to succeed and her desire to give back.

"Thanks to the opportunities offered at BHS, I've advanced my career and found success as a nurse, which led me to leadership. I love taking everything I've learned and sharing it with my staff and the community so we can all succeed."

Nate Laird was afraid a volleyball ankle injury a decade ago might mean the end of his golf career.

"I came down, rolled it, heard the loudest pop I think I've ever heard. My ankle swelled to the size of a small basketball. But I didn't break anything, so no surgery was done."

Over time, his ankle kept deteriorating to the point it would continually dislocate – not ideal for the director of golf operations at The Beloit Club. Club staff and members recommended BHS, where he met James Whelan, DPM, and Medical Assistant Nikki Holloway.

"Nate presented a very advanced pathology with advanced tearing to the collateral ligaments," Dr. Whelan recalls. "He had exhausted many conservative treatment options."

A total ankle reconstruction was required. The care and support Nate received before, during and after relieved any apprehensions he may have had.

"I couldn't have asked for a better group. Dr. Whelan and his medical assistant, Nikki Holloway, made sure I was taken care of. Nikki was by far the best I've ever worked with. I knew every procedure. Every message sent through the portal, every phone call, she provided answers."

Dr. Whelan is quick to agree regarding Nikki's contributions to the Podiatry team.

"She's a true patient advocate who embodies BHS's core values." He continued, "She goes above and beyond to ensure high-quality patient care ... Nikki is a huge asset to our practice."

Nate is happy to report his surgery was successful and his recovery is ahead of schedule.

"I was swinging a club just two months from surgery. It has allowed me to succeed and become a better golfer."

Dr. Whelan calls Nate's ankle reconstruction one of BHS' "biggest success stories." He credits the BHS culture of excellence for his own success.

"They've really helped me elevate my career by supporting me and providing the foundation for me to provide comprehensive clinical services."

In 2022, Beloit Health System garnered an impressive number of accolades and rankings, a well-deserved reflection of this organization's extraordinary people and their unwavering dedication to excellence.

Fitch Ratings, Inc., one of the influential "big three" credit ratings agencies, renewed its A investment grade for Beloit Health System, based on strong market position and consistent operating profitability.

BHS has seen success across multiple specialty areas. After a thorough review, The Joint Commission renewed Beloit Health System's accreditation for another three years in acknowledgement of continuing dedication to quality care and patient safety.

For the sixth consecutive year, Beloit Health System's At-Home Healthcare service was recognized with the Patient Satisfaction Award of Distinction by WellSky, based on results of their Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) survey.

Of course, a story about quality wouldn't be complete without mention of BHS volunteers. The Volunteers In Partnership (VIP) program plays a vital role in enhancing the patient and visitor experience. This year alone, the 176 active VIP members have volunteered a total of 14,160 hours, equaling \$424,106 in value. NEW TECHNOLOGY. COMMUNITY INITIATIVES. SAVING LIVES. TOGETHER.



Stable financial standings are providing Beloit Health System with opportunities to purchase new technologies that serve the community. A new, state-of-the-art MRI machine upgrade is one example.

"The new MRI machine brings advanced technologies and service enhancements. This will allow overall satisfaction for our clinicians as well as greater care for the patients in the community we serve," stated BHS Vice President Nommo Donald.

Director of Medical Imaging Jennifer Yeadon explains how patients can expect a more comfortable experience.

"The new MRI machine brings advanced technologies and service enhancements. This will allow overall satisfaction for our clinicians as well as greater care for the patients in the community we serve."



"The biggest thing is the opening of the magnet. Currently, we're at 60cm and with the new MRI machine we are going up to 71cm. There will be a lot more space. The tube that patients go into will also be shorter, so you don't feel like you're going into a tunnel," Yeadon said.

The new machine's technological advancements will allow for a much greater range of exams, leading to more rapid diagnoses for patients.

"We'll have the ability to do exams that are sometimes sent out of the health system to other facilities," said Clinical Manager of Medical Imaging Debbra Bauman. "Patients will be able to have exams right away, here in our community."

Yeadon agreed, adding, "We'll be more efficient and more successful with the overall experience for our patients."



COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT

Beloit Health System is committed to providing support through crisis intervention education in topics affecting our community. For example, Beloit Health System has partnered with Vivent Health to offer free NARCAN® (over-the-counter opioid overdose treatment) kits and training. This initiative is aiding marginalized communities and saving lives while increasing awareness and prevention.

In 2018 Brooke McKearn lost her 23-year-old son to fentanyl poisoning. Today she works as a prevention specialist at Vivent, conducting free NARCAN training classes offered in cooperation with Beloit Health System.

"The partnership has been nothing but smooth, easy and informative," she said. "Everybody I've talked to has been on board with getting the training, from media and marketing to the CEO, Tim McKevett."

SUCCESS THAT SEES CONTINUED GROWTH.

Beloit Health System's most prominent success story is the construction of the Freestanding Birth Center. This alternative care model focuses on a natural birth and setting for low-risk patients during pregnancy, labor/delivery and postpartum and will open in Fall 2023.

The birth center fills a need for the community, which is excited about the new experience. Allison Brown, a nearby resident and new parent, explains why.

"There's a growing population of people, including myself, who are excited because it's a good solution between home birth and hospital. You have all the comforts of a more natural situation, and still have nurses and midwives to help if you need it," Allison said.





She added, "I know a lot of people who are excited about this. The nearest facility like this is quite a ways away. It's going to be popular, having this kind of facility this close."

In addition to expansion, BHS' successful growth relies on recruiting quality people. People like pain management specialist Alfred Rosche, M.D., who stresses the importance of the physician/patient relationship as the key to successful treatment.

"It's sacred. If someone feels you have their best interests in mind, that you'll do anything you can to help them, people really respond to that, and it sets the table for excellent patient recovery."

He sees BHS as an opportunity to share his expertise and provide a higher level of care for a greater number of patients.

"Becoming a part of Beloit Health System has given me so many more advantages in my practice. It's allowed me to see different types of patients and add exciting new care options. This is a good route for success as an individual, a system and a hospital."

Another member of the BHS team providing highquality and innovative care is Michal Gutowski, M.D., who specializes in eye surgery and glaucoma treatment. He brings enthusiasm for patient healing and a unique skill set that includes a new glaucoma treatment.

"I've introduced laser treatments for glaucoma as well as some minimally invasive glaucoma surgeries that had not previously been done at Beloit Health System."

He sees joining BHS' Ophthalmology department as an ideal partnership.

"I have an excellent support staff and OR team. I get to focus on patient care. Ultimately that leads to my success as a physician and to community success because they're taken care of."






